Job Description: Centerville Fire Rescue (CFR) is a newly formed ALS E-911 service based out of the Centerville Fire Department. CFR will serve as the primary E-911 service for Appanoose County covering approximately 1250 calls for service annually beginning in January of 2019.

Job Summary: Paramedics and EMTs will respond to E911 calls and provide care based on State of Iowa Scope of Practice. Employees will assist in providing community educational courses and public safety education throughout Appanoose County.

Paramedic Position Requirements:

- Must hold current State of Iowa or National Certification as Paramedic. Preference given to applicants with Critical Care Paramedic/Paramedic Specialist certifications.
- Good written and verbal communications skills
- Ability to function as a member of a team and independently in an emergency medicine setting
- Ability to accurately complete ePCRs in a timely manner.
- Position will require a pre-employment physical to be performed at City expense.

- Ability to accurately complete ePCRs in a timely manner.

- Ability to function as a member of a team in an emergency medicine setting
